The government first introduced the act in 2008. it was recently updated in July 2024.

The purpose of this Act is to encourage waste minimisation and a decrease in waste disposal.

Practically that means the government wants us to reduce the amount of waste that we are sending to landfill. Tirohia landfill is due to close in 2025 and Hampton Downs is expected to last until 2030. These are the only landfills that are currently operating in the Waikato region. This makes it even more important to play our part to reduce what we are sending to landfill where we can.
